ANNUAL ALUMNI MEMORIAL FOREST VISIT JUNE 12TH

THE ANNUAL ALUMNI VISIT TO THE MEMORIAL FOR-EST WILL BE FRIDAY JUNE 12TH, THE DAY BEFORE THE CLASS OF 38'S 60TH JUNE 13TH REUNION. BASED UPON THE APPRECIATION EXPRESSED FOR LAST YEARS VISIT, THE ALUMNI BOARD HAS DECIDED TO MAKE THIS SOJURN AN ANNUAL EVENT. DEPENDING UPON THE RESPONSE RECEIVED, BUSSES WILL BE SOUGHT FROM THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO TRANSPORT ALUMNI AND STUDENTS FOR THE VISIT.

DURING THE VISIT, A SHORT CEREMONY WILL BE HELD DEDICATING MEMORIAL BENCHES AND PLAQUES MADE POSSIBLE THROUGH ALUMNI DONATIONS. TWO BENCHES HAVE BEEN COMMISSIONED. ONE AT THE ROCK AND ANOTHER HALF WAY ALONG THE TRAIL FOR RESTING ON THE RETURN TRIP. STUDENTS IN THE CLEVELAND FOUNDRY CLASSES ARE PREPARING A PLAQUE HONORING CLEVELAND ALUMNI WHO DIED IN THE KOREAN AND VIETNAM CONFLICTS. THIS PLAQUE WILL BE PLACED ON THE ROCK NEXT TO THE ONE HONORING WW II DEAD. THE NAME OF JERO KANETOMI WILL ALSO BE ADDED TO THE WW II PLAQUE.

SINCE OUR LAST VISIT, MUCH WORK HAS BEEN DONE AT THE FOREST, INCLUDING A NEW ROOF ON THE "A" FRAME, EXTENSIVE REMODELING OF THE CARETAKERS SHACK, TRAIL WORK, AND REMOVAL OF MANY OF THE LARGE HAZARDOUS TREES.

LAST YEARS FOREST VISIT WAS CONSIDERED BY MANY AS THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE 70TH WEEKEND. OUR MEMORIAL FOREST IS INDEED AN INSPIRATIONAL TRIBUTE TO OUR HONORED FELLOW STUDENTS. WE HOPE TO SEE YOU AT THE SITE JUNE 12TH.
